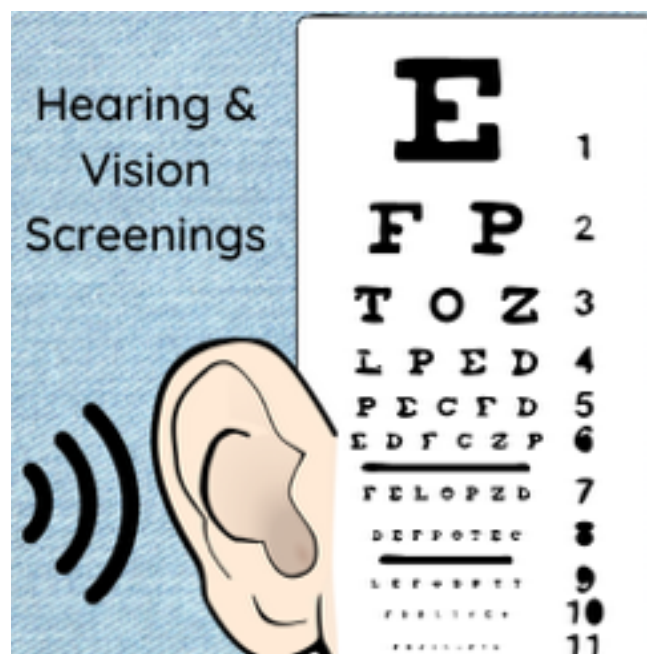
Time Commitment: 4 hours

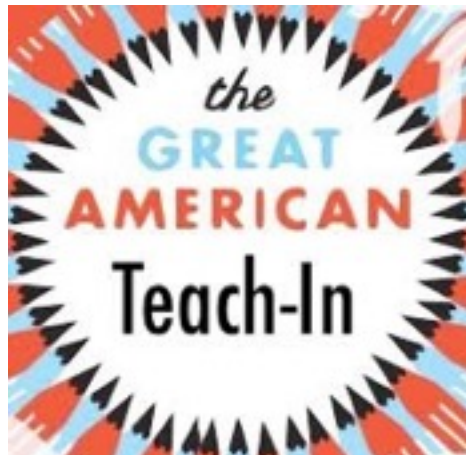
Time Commitment: 1-2 hours
