- Wednesdays 8:45-3:00

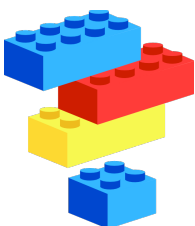


_____ Room Parent

- Time Commitment: 2-3 hours per month



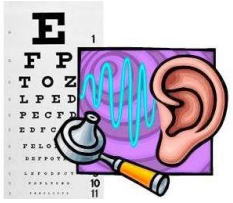
_____ Uniform Exchange Coordinator
