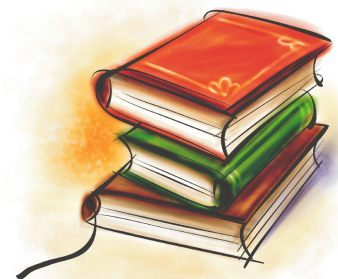


1. The Library Coordinator and Assistants empower students to be enthusiastic readers and supports students' success by guiding them in reading for understanding and for pleasure.

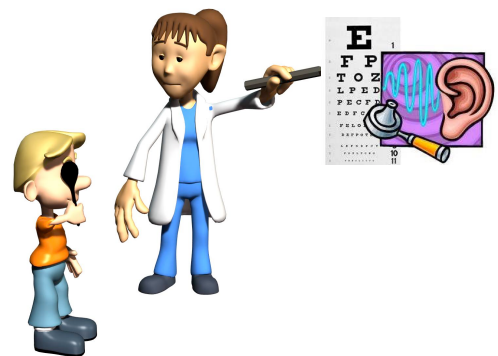
